	founded more than 100 years ago in the U.S.
	and now operates in 13 countries of the world
	including Russia. Our aim is to help children
	from a disadvantaged environment ("Littles")
	to achieve their life potential through
	professionally supported relationships with
	adult volunteer-mentors ("Bigs") "Big
	Brothers Big Sisters" provide. The friendship
	relationships between matched "Bigs" and
	"Littles" are developed under the observation

Our Aims	With the help of professional psychologists,
	volunteers and social workers we support
	children in difficult life situations (orphans,
	children from dysfunctional families, disabled
	children) through the mechanisms of individual
	social adaptation.
	Our organization is also a resource center in
	which volunteers take special classes for
	working with orphans or children from
0 7	dysfunctional families.
Our Program	We match caring adults to those children who
	need their attention and care.
	We find and train adult volunteers for one-to-
	one relationships with children facing
	adversity. The program targets children from 5
	to 17 years of age, including orphans, children
	from broken or dysfunctional families and
	children with restricted abilities.
	The training process for volunteers includes an
	interview, psycho-diagnosis, submission of the
	necessary documents and recommendations
	and the training course. Subsequently the
	program specialists select a child who needs
	individual support and introduce him/her to the

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	volunteer. This is how we create the "Big-
	Little" couple and they begin to meet once
	every week. A volunteer must take part in the
	program for at least one year. The volunteer
	1 0
	and the child spend time together, play games,
	do homework, do sports, attend exhibitions
	and concerts or just chat. The volunteer
	becomes a role model for the child, the model
	of a significant adult. "Big" is a friend able to
	help the "Little" find answers to all manner of
	important personal questions.
	Our experience of the mentoring program has
	shown that if a few hours every week are
	devoted to a child from an adverse family
	situation, the child's general emotional
	condition improves, his/her confidence and
	ability for self-assessment also improve. The
	child becomes more communicative, able to
	take initiative, he/she shows more interest in
	learning and shows a greater interest in what is
	happening around him/her. When a child feels
	that someone cares for him, he becomes
	successful and strong.
	In 2009 we provided mentoring support for
	630 children from the regions where we
	operate.
